One Hand Strapping Tool and Slot Punch Pliers: preparation for applying a customs-approved seal

1 To apply a customs-approved seal to a package, you need polypropylene strapping, a strapping seal, the One Hand Strapping Tool and the Slot Punch Pliers.



2 To tightly wrap the package with strapping, load a strapping seal into the One Hand Strapping Tool



3 Slide one end of the strapping from the back of the mechanism to the front, threading it through the loaded strapping seal. Then firmly press down the tension lever.



4 Push the other end of the strapping through the loaded strapping seal and then through the cross-head holder. Tighten the strapping around the package by rocking the lever back and forth.



When the required tension is achieved, push the button at the end of the tension lever, and continue to rock the lever back and forth until there is some resistance. This means that the ends of the strapping are now connected by the strapping seal. Firmly press down the tension lever to cut the strap. The tool can now be removed.



6 Slide the mouth of the Slot Punch Pliers fully over the strapping seal.



7 Press the lever arm down to punch a slot through the strapping seal.



8 The package is now ready to be secured with a customs-approved seal.
